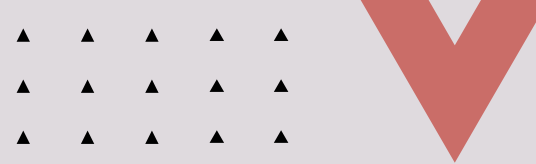

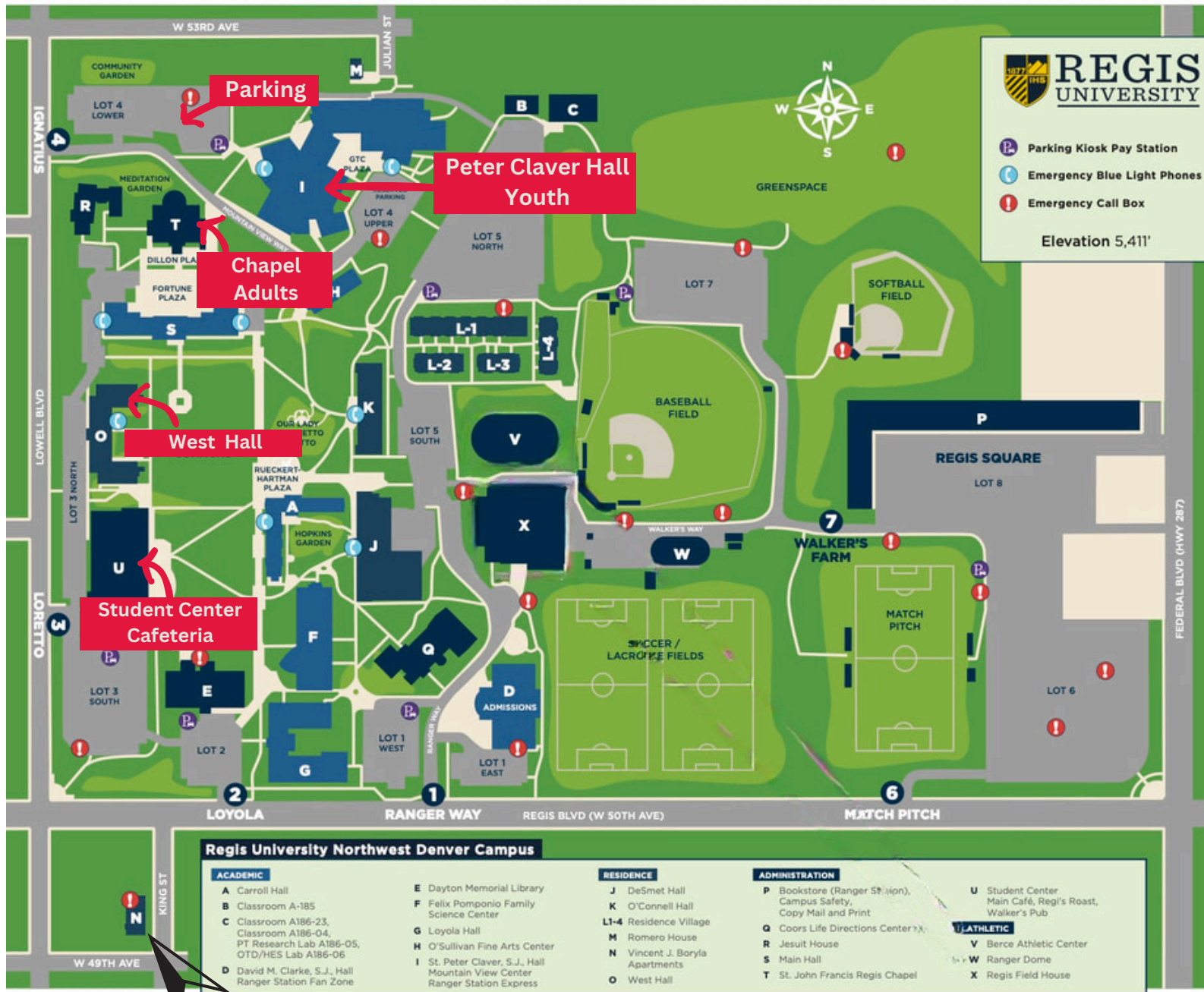

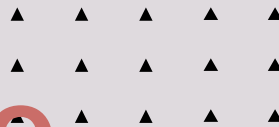

GENERAL CAMP RULES & INFO.



Punctuality & Reverence: Please be punctual and conduct yourself appropriately at all sessions. In addition, we urge attendees to replace heavy applause with vocal affirmations, such as “Amen”.

Participation: Campers must participate fully in all meetings. Please refrain from standing outside the meeting places when meetings are in progress. Chaperones and Youth Leaders must ensure that all dormitories are locked up during meetings.

Dressing: Your dressing should reflect the professional nature of an Adventist Pathfinder, Youth or Young Adult and respect the principles of Christian modesty, decency and simplicity.

Minors: Must be accompanied at all times by a Chaperone/Responsible Adult (21+), who will assume responsibility and be accountable for both the safety and behavior of the minor.

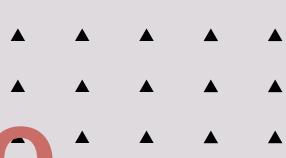
Room Allocation: No camper should move from the dormitory assigned to him/her without the approval of the local youth leader and the registration team leader.

Room Keys: Please take good care of your room key. If you lose it, you will have to reimburse your church for it.

Damage to Property: Campers must not deface dormitory walls or damage any campsite property, any damage caused would be charged to the culprit at replacement value.



GENERAL CAMP RULES & INFO.



Visiting Rooms of the Opposite Sex Unlawful (under camp rules), Prohibited, & Categorically Not Allowed: Campers are strongly advised not to enter the dormitories or rooms of the opposite sex. Female dormitories and rooms are out of bounds to males and male dormitories are also out of bounds to females. Any camper who violates this camp rule will face disciplinary action, including expulsion from the camp and exclusion from attending future youth camp(s).

No Guests in Your Rooms: Anyone who is not a registered camper is a guest. Do not receive guests in your rooms unless you have received permission from your Pathfinder/Youth Leader. Under no circumstance should a camper allow a guest to sleep in their room. All guests are expected to make their own accommodation arrangements.

Leaving Camp Site Without Express Permission: Campers are advised not to leave the campsite without obtaining written permission from Camp Directors. This and other offenses may result in dismissal from the camp.

Comfort and Convenience: Although comfort and convenience are not the primary objectives of the youth camp, many efforts have been made to make all campers feel comfortable. However, should any camper have suggestions or special requests, please feel free to direct these to the appropriate camp officers.

Respect for Others: Please be reminded that the campsite is a campus of higher learning. There are other residents on campus engaging in various activities who may be sharing facilities with us. Please respect their rights to go about their activities with minimum distraction. Refrain from making unusual noises, particularly at night.

Meals: Meals will be served only at times specified in the camp program. Meal tickets will be required in order to enter the dining room. If you miss the meal time, please do not go to the dining room as there will be no food for you outside the specified meal times. Do not take your guests to the dining room without seeking permission from the Meal Coordinators and purchasing the appropriate meal vouchers.
